TEST STANDARD

Developed to meet the latest UK flood standards our timber flood door is Kitemark™ Certified to BS 851188-2019 for both inward and outward opening units being the first of their kind to achieve this standard in the UK.

As part of the BSI test, the door has to withstand a 900mm depth of water for 4 days, with wave, current and impact testing as well as 5000 cycle opening and closing test on the handles and locking systems and remain dry at all times.

PERFORMANCE

Low risk of shrinkage, swelling, jamming, insects and fungi damage, means future repair costs are kept to a minimum. Also, thanks to Accoya's superior thermal insulation, heat lost through timber windows and external doors is reduced - keeping homes cosy and energy bills down.
